Practice:

A committee of faculty members is formed to motivate, guide and monitor the students. Students are free to approach the committee to register the names beforehand. The names of the students who are going to keep the stalls should enter their details along with menu and price in the register. Interested students are allowed to display their products for sale like eatables, embroidery work, decorative articles, craft items, articles

prepared from waste materials, mehandi application, handmade fancy bangles, earrings etc.

The eatables which are to be sold are prepared by the students under the supervision of the committee members under hygienic conditions. The students install the stalls during 11.00am to 4.00pm every Thursday. Prices of the items are decided by the committee members and the students. The students have to pay 5.00% of the profitable amount to the college. Under this scheme students are also trained by students of Ideal Fine Arts Kalaburagi to make eco-friendly Lord Ganesh Idol. The Idols prepared by the students are sold under this scheme.

Success:

Students gained the knowledge of communication skill, time management, self-earning, finance management. They experienced joy and at the same time they learn to face the difficulties livelihood.

Problems:

Students found little difficulty in utilizing their leisure time to manage the stalls along with the classes.
