ANNUAL REPORT 2021-22

2nd October, 2021, Mahatma Gandhiji & Lal Bahadur Shastriji Jayanti, Birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi and Lal Bahadur Shastri was celebrated in the College premises on 2nd October, 2021 at 9 AM.
